

Context of the petition

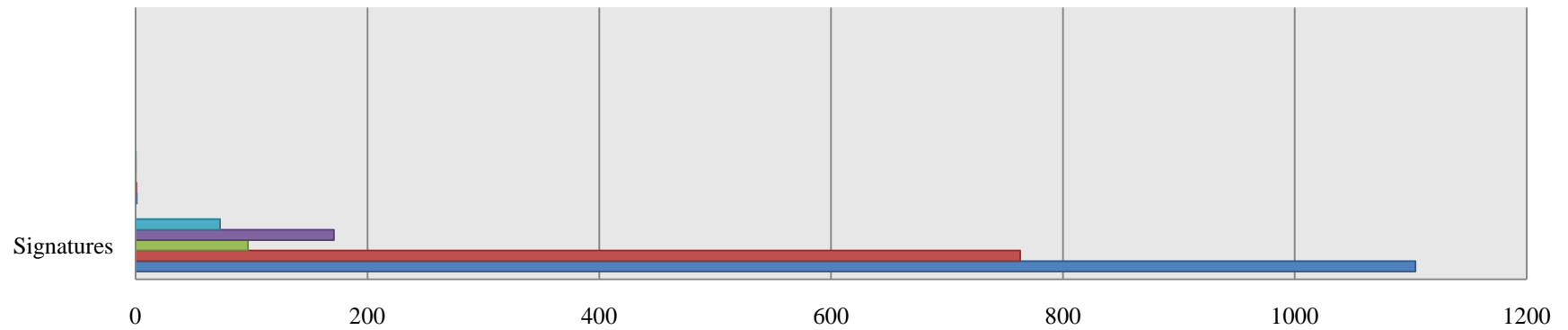
- + Petition active throughout month of April 09.
- + Petition packs distributed mainly to various retailers in Hayle.
- + Petition packs included:
 - ✓ Hayle Seize Her poster/notice.
 - ✓ Important points document, pre-checked for accuracy by HMS Plymouth Association.
 - ✓ Petition forms.

- + Petition was reactive – public were not pro-actively engaged by agents.
- + No door to door or pavement canvassing took place.
- + Not all outlets displayed the petition information in direct public gaze.
- + A number of outlets reported running out of blank forms.
- + One public house had to discard all forms following a bar spillage accident.
- + A total of 86 petition forms were collected and are available upon request.
- + Respondent's initial, surname, 1st line of address, postcode & signature sought.
