**PENWITH DISTRICT COUNCIL ST IVES BAY COAST
PROTECTION ORDER 2003**

Penwith District Council in exercise of its powers under Section 18 of the Coast Protection Act 1949, hereby order as follows:

1. The provisions of Section 18 of the Coast Protection Act 1949 (which prohibit, save under licence, the excavation or removal of any materials (other than minerals more than 50 feet below the surface) on, under or forming any part of any portion of the seashore to which the Section is applied) shall apply to all of the seashore of St Ives Bay between Godrevy Point, grid reference 579433 and Clodgy Point, grid reference 507414.
2. In this Order “the seashore” means the bed and shore of the sea, and of every channel, creek, bay or estuary, and of every river as far up as the tide flows, and any cliff, bank, barrier, dune, beach, flat or other land adjacent to the shore.

3. This Order may be cited as the Penwith District Council, St Ives Bay Coast Protection Order 2003.
